

## FCC COUNCIL 9.25.2024

Judy Basham opened the meeting with prayer. Present were Bob Corbin, Dave Bryan, Sandra Brown, Jacque Hart, Marilyn Leming, Christy Thompson, Lester Freeman, Charles Smith, Pastor Stephen and Nancy Stevenson (minutes). Mike Morriss was absent.

There was no discussion on reports or the agenda so it proceeded to action items.

### OLD BUSINESS

- Friendship Garden: there is no current plan for cleanup or future use. Bob offered to head subcommittee to include Nancy, Tom Hoddy etc.
- Benevolence: consensus was to limit assistance for utilities to \$50 to help more people (instead of increasing to \$65/\$100).. To begin October 1.
- Painting/Flooring: Jacque reported 3 current bids, 1) HRI - \$16K, 2) Watermark \$8K using ladders but \$30K for everything, 3) Floyd Jones \$17.6K but up to \$30K for everything. Habitat can provide scaffolding (liability?). Consensus to start end of October. Consensus to approve \$20K and SFRT to find rest of funds. Flooring: Wards to compensate for carpet damage. Options to use carpet, tile, stain concrete (2 kinds of concrete), or laminate (Sheila Kirkpatrick getting bids). Suggested to use local companies, Anderson, Mock etc.
- Youth Minister Search Team: To include Stephen, Christy, Becky Davis, Jerry Brace, William Adams, Dylan Ives, and Arlene Stauffer.
- Pastor Stephen requested an additional week of vacation in lieu of a pay raise. Approved. Stephen to resolve tax issue of self-employment/housing.
- Choir/Bell Director: Amy Muegge to begin Oct 16.

### NEW BUSINESS

- Lawn sprinkler system: losing grass in places. KRS stretched on work. Rainmaker gave an estimate of \$1883 for 9 needed heads. Approved to come from discretionary funds.
- Repair/replace stolen and vandalized drainage pipes torn off side of building: consensus to use non-copper (vinyl-aluminum) materials and Tues Guys labor/Kim Stauffer. More security cameras needed.
- Pizza Dinner sponsored by Challengers after Sept 29 late service.
