#### **Images of Lent**

As we approach the celebration of Easter, we must first pass through the days of reflection during the season of Lent. This series of images bring the story of the final days of Jesus to the forefront of our meditations as we ponder the intersection of the ministry of Christ and our own experiences.



Luke 22:20 And he did the same with the cup after supper, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."

The cup that was shared between Jesus and the apostles was filled with wine that had been pressed some time earlier. It had come from grapes that grew on a vine tended by people who had no idea that the wine they were making that season would become part of a symbol of the new covenant that would bring people into a deeper relationship with God for centuries to come.

That particular wine was not what made that moment special. Nor are the elements for communion that are used today sacred on their own. It is when we partake of them with intention that they take on the character of sacred elements. Their sacred nature does not come from their substance, but from our awareness.

As we live through this time of deeper intention of reflection, allow your perspective to shift to an awareness of the sacred in everyday observations. See the beauty of God's creation that surrounds you. Allow the simplest elements of your environment to illicit moments of wonder as you ponder the intricacies of creation.
